30th ANNUAL IDAHO YOUTH RANCH BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT 2010

Benefiting Idaho Kids and Families

We'd like to welcome all 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade boys basketball teams to register for this year's Tournament! Proceeds from your enjoyment and experience in this tournament contribute to our mission of providing kids and families with a bridge to a responsible and productive future. We're privileged to provide this annual event to our Southern Idaho communities, and look forward to your participation.

Team Size: A team may consist of 10 players. We provide up to 10 shirts for players. If you have over 10 players you must pay \$9.00 for additional shirts (as well as their entry fee). Please notify me asap if you know you will have over 10 players, so I can order more shirts.

Entry Fee: \$15 per participant if registered by "early entry" date. \$20 per participant if registered by "deadline entry" date (dates are provided on next page). This fee helps cover costs for shirts, referees, insurance, and awards. We will provide concessions for purchase, including light dinner items, snacks, and beverages. We hold this tournament as a community service and as a healthy opportunity for the youth here as well as those participating.

Games/Schedule: This is a double elimination tournament, so teams are guaranteed to play at least two games in the actual tournament. Last year we were able to have a round robin play-off Thursday and Friday, which we may do this year as well (depending on the amount of teams that sign up). Initial bracket schedules will be emailed to registered teams one week prior to the tournament. I will also call each coach the Monday before the tournament starts, with game time information. Games will be held Thursday and Friday evening, and all day Saturday.

Awards: Awards will be given to each player on the 1st and 2nd place teams. Awards will also be given to the MVP of each team which will be determined by Ranch staff and coaches. There will also be a 3-pt. contest where two persons from each team may compete. Awards will be given to first and second place.

Refunds/Cancellation: If you request a refund up to ten (10) days prior to the tournament, you will be issued a refund minus a \$20 processing fee. If there are less than five (5) teams for a tournament, that tournament will be canceled, and full refunds will be issued.

New! Housing: There may be some accommodations to those interested to stay overnight at the ranch. We have some housing units available, as well as meals, Please call me for reservations and costs!

Application: Please fill out and return the enclosed application with your entry fee. Entry slots are limited, so send your fee in ASAP to assure your place in the tournament. (Address located on the top of this page). Coaches are responsible to make sure each player, and his/her parents have read the **Coach Waiver** section of the application. The coaches signature represents that each player and his/her parents, as well as the coach, have read and understands the risks involved with participation in the tournament before player participates.

Tournament Rules

1. There will be 6 minute quarters and a 3 minute half-time
2. 5 minute warm-up
3. A title 9 ball(28.5) will be used for all girls and 5th and 6th boys
4. A full court press may be used (use good sportsmanship if up by more than 20)
5. A zone or man-on-man defense may be used
6. 7th team foul =1&1; 10th team foul=2 shots
7. 3 full timeouts and two 30second timeouts per game, and 1 additional per overtime
8. If a team is up by more than 30 points during the 4th quarter, the clock won't stop on dead balls
9. Overtime 1st is 3 minutes; 2nd and beyond is 1 minute
10. **Parents, coaches, or fans demonstrating verbally abusive conduct will not be tolerated. Those who exhibit such behaviors will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to return.**
11. Officials can give a technical to fans, coaches, and players.
12. High school Federation Rules
13. Tournament Director will discuss any problems with HEAD COACH ONLY
14. Players may play up a grade, but not down.
15. If there is a round robin play, same rules apply except:
 1. quarters, half time, and time outs may be diff. from tournie rules depending on number of teams that sign up
 2. First team to 30 wins

Visitor Rules

1. No contraband is permitted on Ranch Campus (cigarettes, alcohol, etc...)
2. All clothing must be appropriate. No clothing which promotes cigarettes, alcohol or any other drugs. No gang apparel is permitted on Ranch
3. Visitors are only permitted in the Recreational Center and adjoining areas. Visitors are not allowed near resident or staff housing, or the arena area.
4. No smoking on campus
5. No firearms or anything else that could be viewed as a weapon are permitted on Ranch.
6. Visitors may be searched prior to entering any lodge.
7. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or non prescription drugs will be asked to leave Ranch premises.
8. Pets must be left in vehicles.
9. Due to the possibility of injuries, visiting children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
10. The Idaho Youth Ranch is not responsible to loss or damage to personal property.

Violations to any Ranch rules will result in visitors being asked to leave the Ranch. Further visits will be left to the discretion of the Ranch Staff.
